Accommodation

Participants will stay in comfortable, centrally located accommodations, ensuring easy access to both the conference venue and Vienna's attractions. All accommodation costs are covered by TU Wien. The accommodation will be in various student houses across Vienna with OeAD Student Housing:

- OeAD Student Housing
- Locations: Gasgasse, Kandlgasse, Sechshauser Strasse, and Tigergasse

The keys to accessing your accommodation will be prepared for you at <u>TU Wien Main building</u> at the EULiST Student Conference registration desk upon arrival. Be sure to pick up your key on the 29th or 30th of July in the 2pm – 10pm timeframe.

Please, take care of the rooms and houses. If needed, ask for assistance. The OEAD office and the event WhatsApp group are available to help with any issues. In case of any damages occuring, the costs are charged to the individual responsible.





For **the check-out**, please leave your room key in the designated box at your student house. The check-out on 4th of July is scheduled by 2PM at latest, on 5th of July, please respect the check-out time at 9AM sharp.

Note that you will not be able to **store your luggage** at the student housing after checking out. To store your luggage in Vienna, we recommend using <u>Bounce</u>, <u>Luggage Hero</u> or designated spots at the train network <u>ÖBB Stations</u>: Wien Mainstation, Westbahnhof, Wien Mitte, Meidling, Praterstern.

Catering

Meals will be served in the TU cafeteria. Participants will be divided into two groups, with details explained during registration. You will choose your meals through an online survey conducted before the event.

Exception: the dinner on Sunday, 30th June will be served in the <u>Kuppelsaal / The</u> Dome.

Transport Info

TU Wien will sponsor a ticket for 5 days (30.06. - 4.07.) for all registered participants of the EULiST Student Conference. You will get the ticket at the official registration where you also pick up your room key. In case of ticket loss, tickets will not be reissued.

Please be aware that your first transport from the train station or airport to the venue will not be covered. You can purchase the ticket online through the <u>Wiener Linien app</u> or the <u>ÖBB app</u>.

To get around Vienna, have a look on <u>the map of Vienna transport</u> and download the <u>Wiener Linien app</u>, or hire a bike (Wiener Linien, Nextbike) as there is a <u>bike station nearby</u> the venue.
