

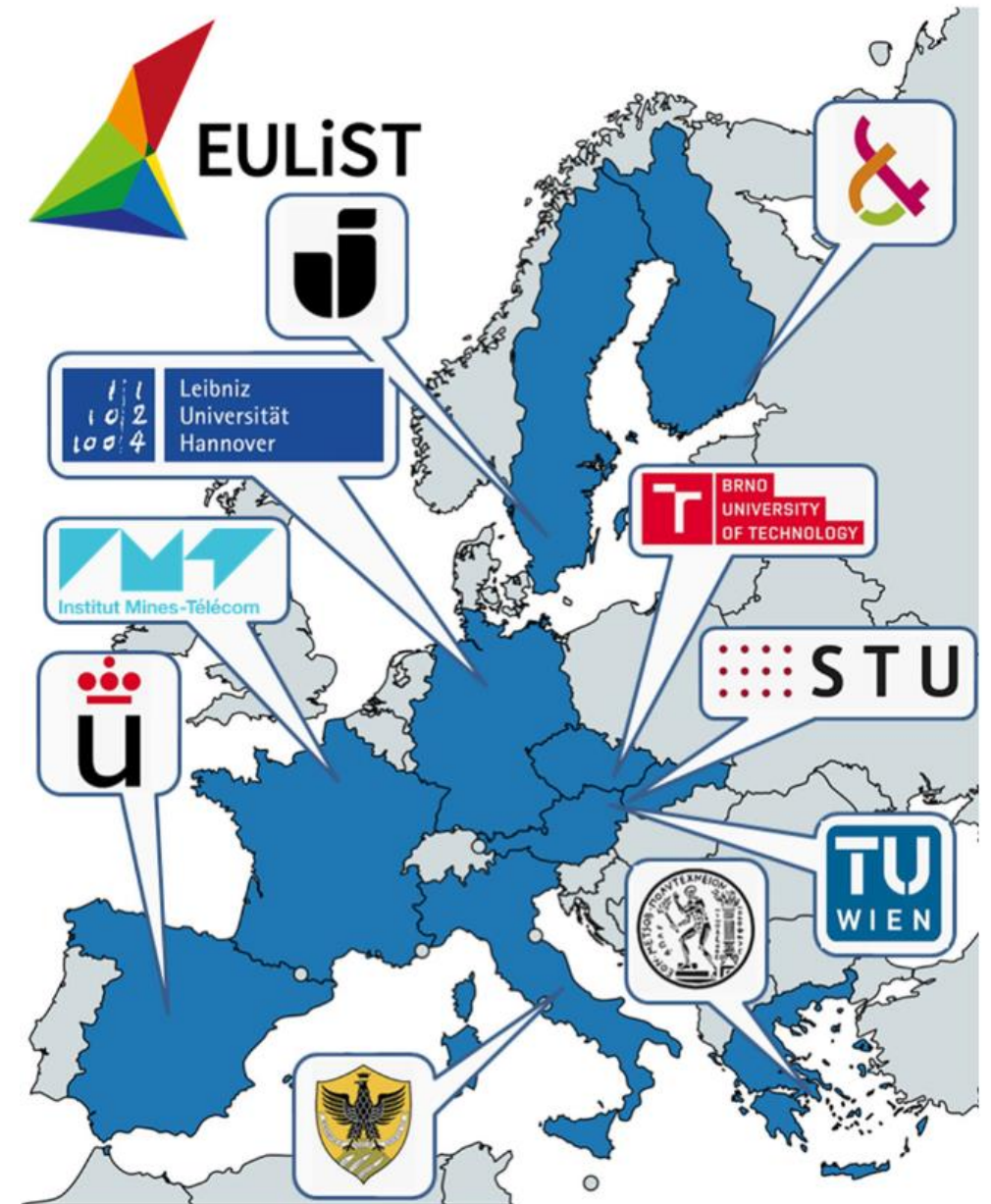

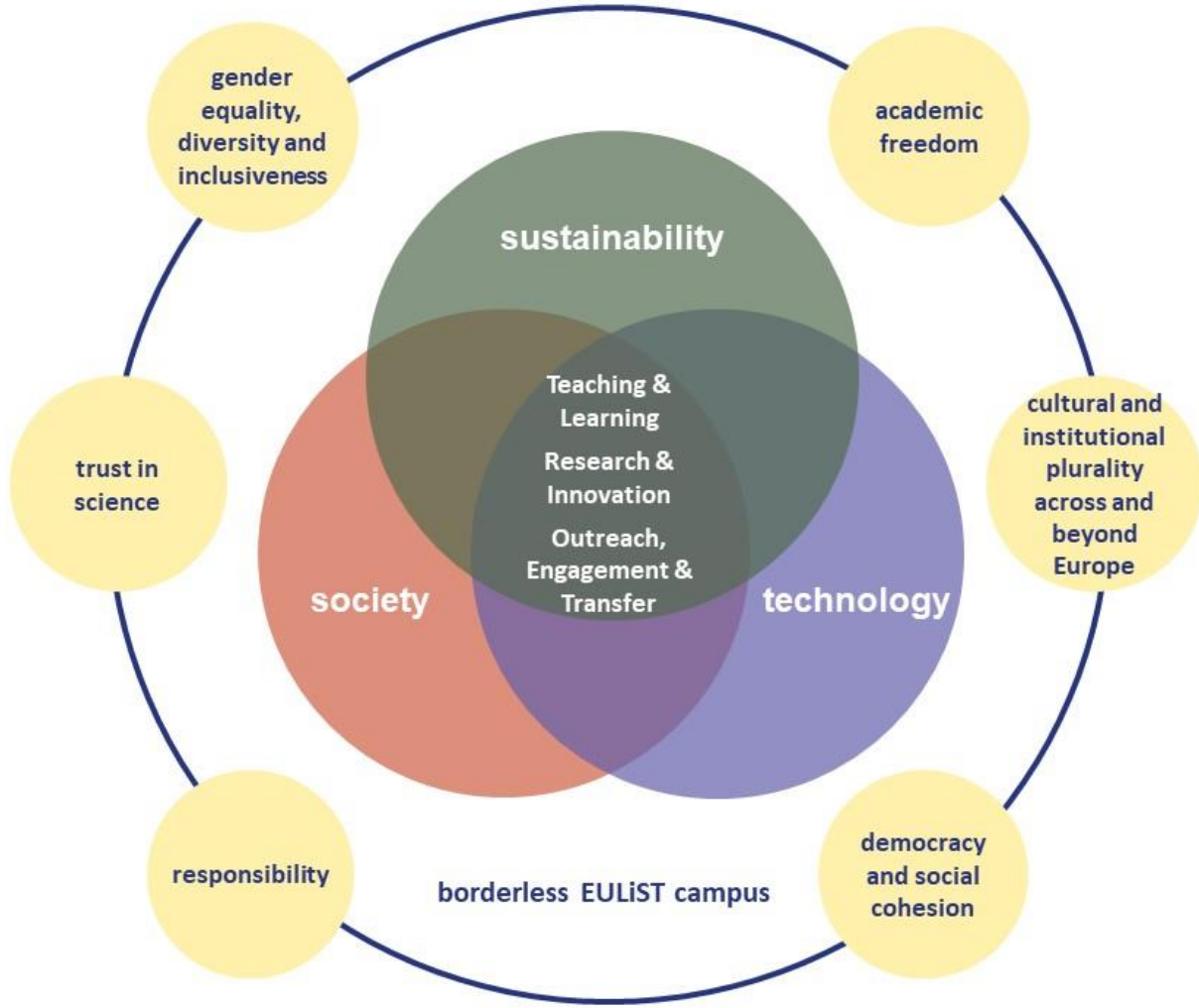


Partners

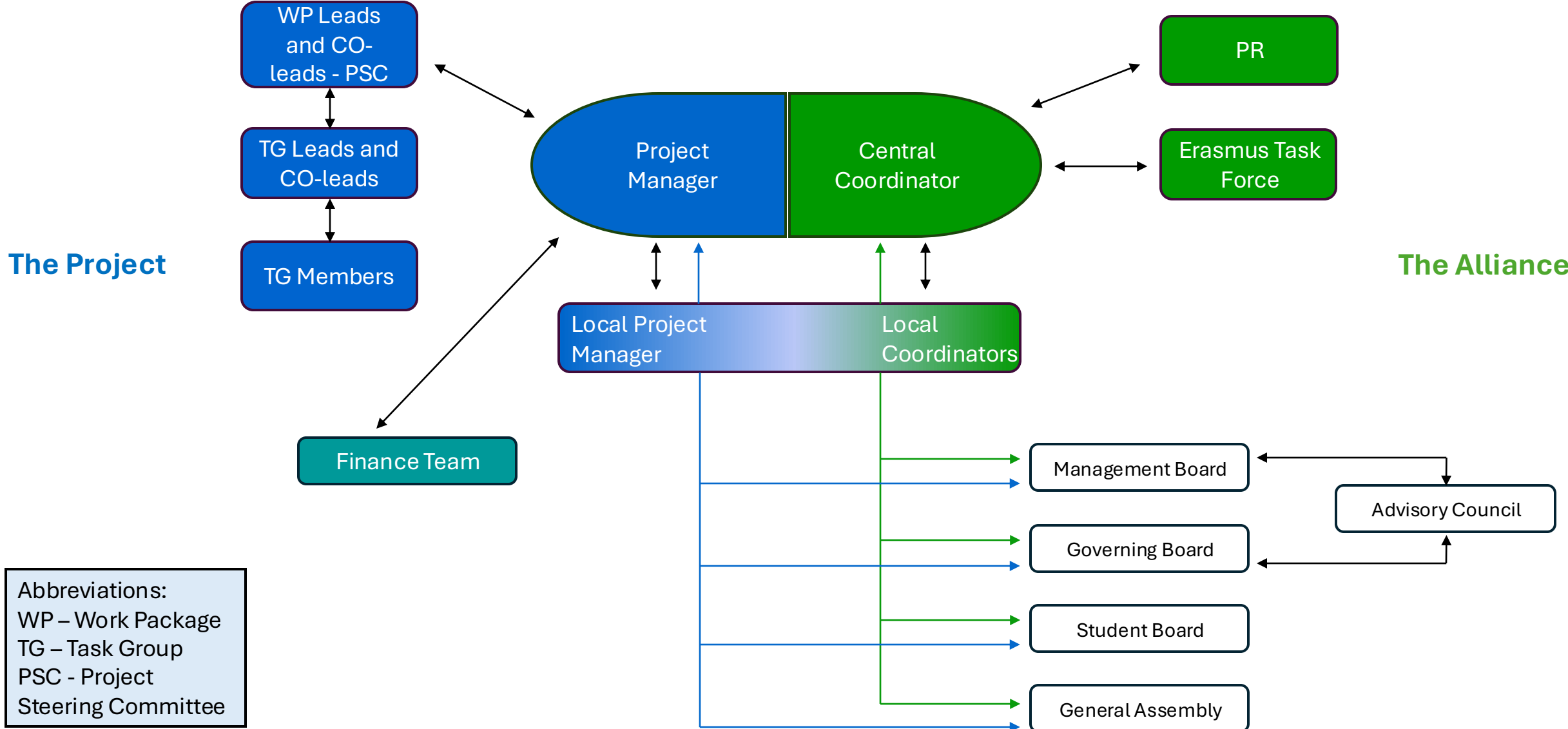
Goals and Work Packages
