The virtual training will focus on some technical preparations that will facilitate the physical activities.

Participation Costs:

The programme is free of charge. Students may apply for the Erasmus+ grants offered by their home university. Interested students should contact their Erasmus+ coordinator or the EULiST coordinator for more information on financing possibilities.

Who can apply?

- Bachelor students (at least 2 years enrolled) and Master students in Business Administration, Management, or Economics at partner universities.
- **Minimum age:** 18 years old

Application Period

First call: 22.03.2026

Second call: 22.04.2026 (only applicable to some partner universities)

Students are required to submit all required documents by the application deadline. Applications outside the above period will not be accepted.

Application Process

To apply for the BIP Course, please follow these steps:

1. Get in contact with your coordinator & apply internally
2. Your home coordinator will evaluate your application
3. If your application was successful, your home coordinator will nominate you to LUH
4. Please send us your application documents:
 - Signed application form
 - Official academic transcript of records
 - Proof of English language proficiency (B2) → (if English is not your mother tongue);
 - Certificate of enrollment
 - Curriculum Vitae (CV);
 - Copy of your passport;
 - Motivation letter (max. 1 page)

By end of April 2026, you will receive final confirmation of your participation, along with further instructions.
